

Cosy Cabin Stocking



Finished size (approx.): 11 x 16½"

Fabric Requirements

- 2 pieces of background fabric (light blue) 12 x 18"
- 2 pieces of cuff fabric (red) 4 x 10"
- An assortment of small scraps for the appliqué design

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut two pieces of background fabric (light blue) 12 x 18". Using the pattern included in this file, trace the stocking pattern onto one (1) of the background fabric pieces.



2. Applique the design onto the background fabric, using your favorite method..



3. Before cutting the stocking out, check again with the pattern and retrace, if necessary, in the event that any shrinkage occurred while appliqueing.

4. Place the applique piece on top of the second piece of background fabric, wrong sides together. Cut out the front and back stocking pieces.

5. Cut out 2 cuff pieces and sew to the top of both stocking pieces. If you wish, applique or embroider a name on the front stocking cuff.



6. Follow the instructions given on the next page to line and finish the stocking.

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ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: *These instructions are for assembling any stocking pattern with a lining.*

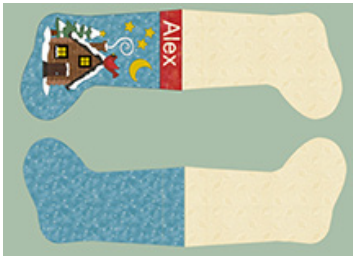
1. Assemble your stocking “top” following the instructions on the first page for the pattern given in this file.



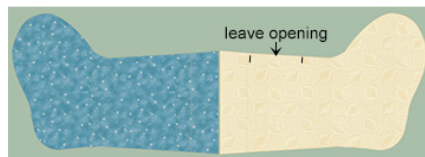
2. Cut out 1 stocking back (reverse pattern) of matching fabric, and two pieces of lining (right sides together), using the stocking/cuff pattern included in this file (join the stocking and cuff patterns before cutting out).



3. Sew the lining to the stocking front and back along the top edge.



4. With the right sides together, sew both pieces together along the outer edges, leaving an opening along lining edge (about 4-5"). Clip curves and turn inside out. Sew the opening closed.



5. Cut a piece of ribbon 6-7" long. Fold in half and attach to the stocking on the inside.

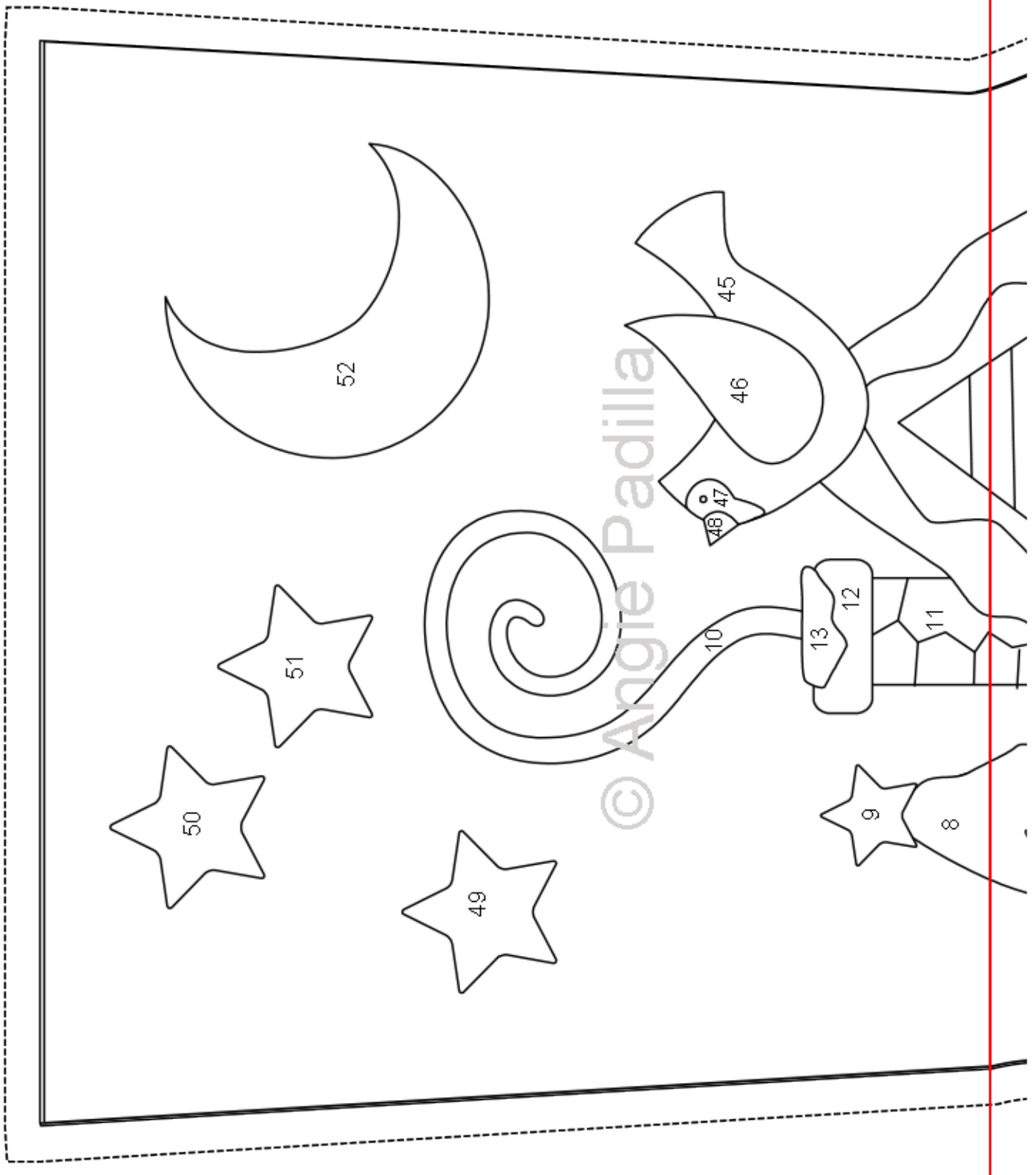

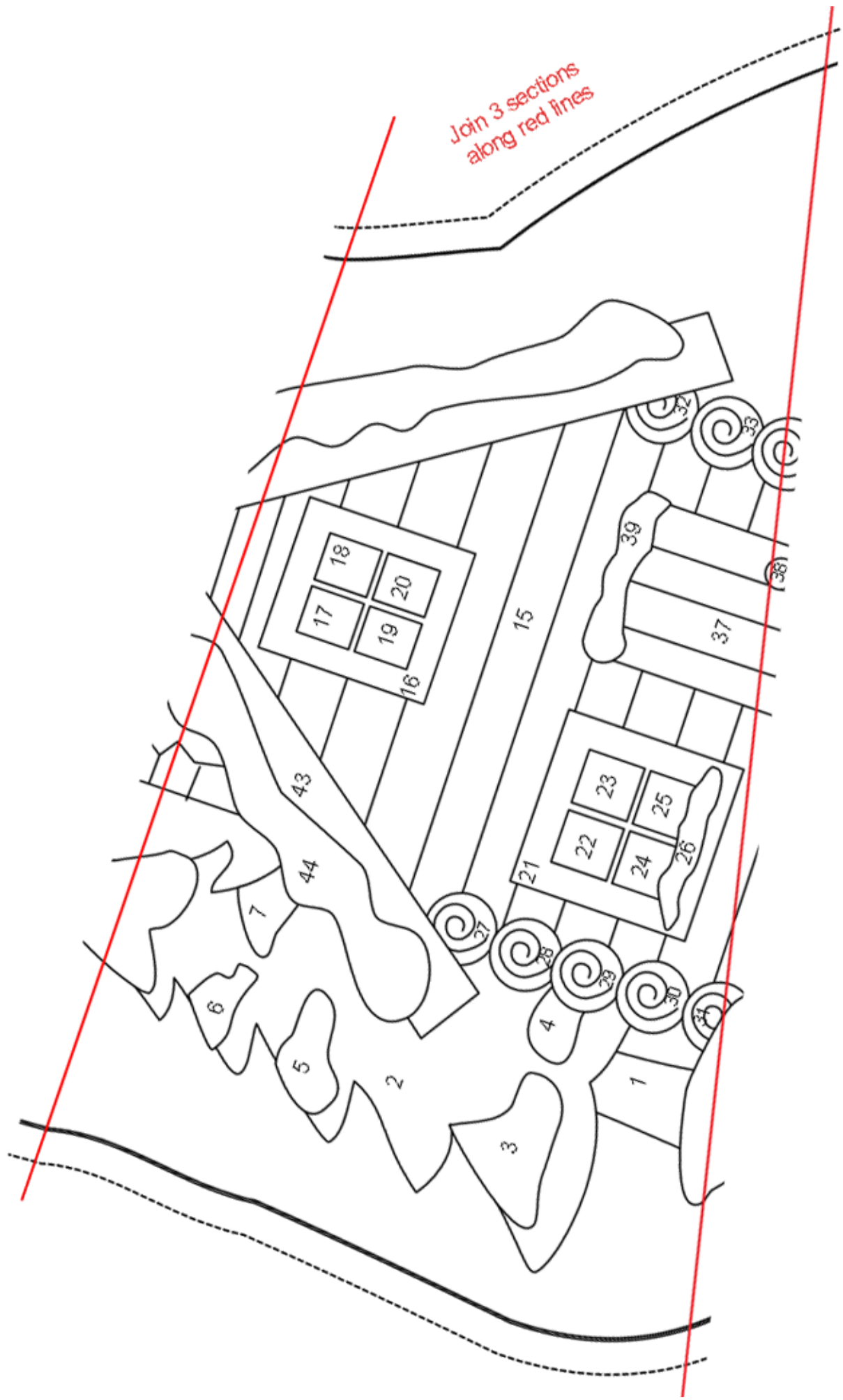

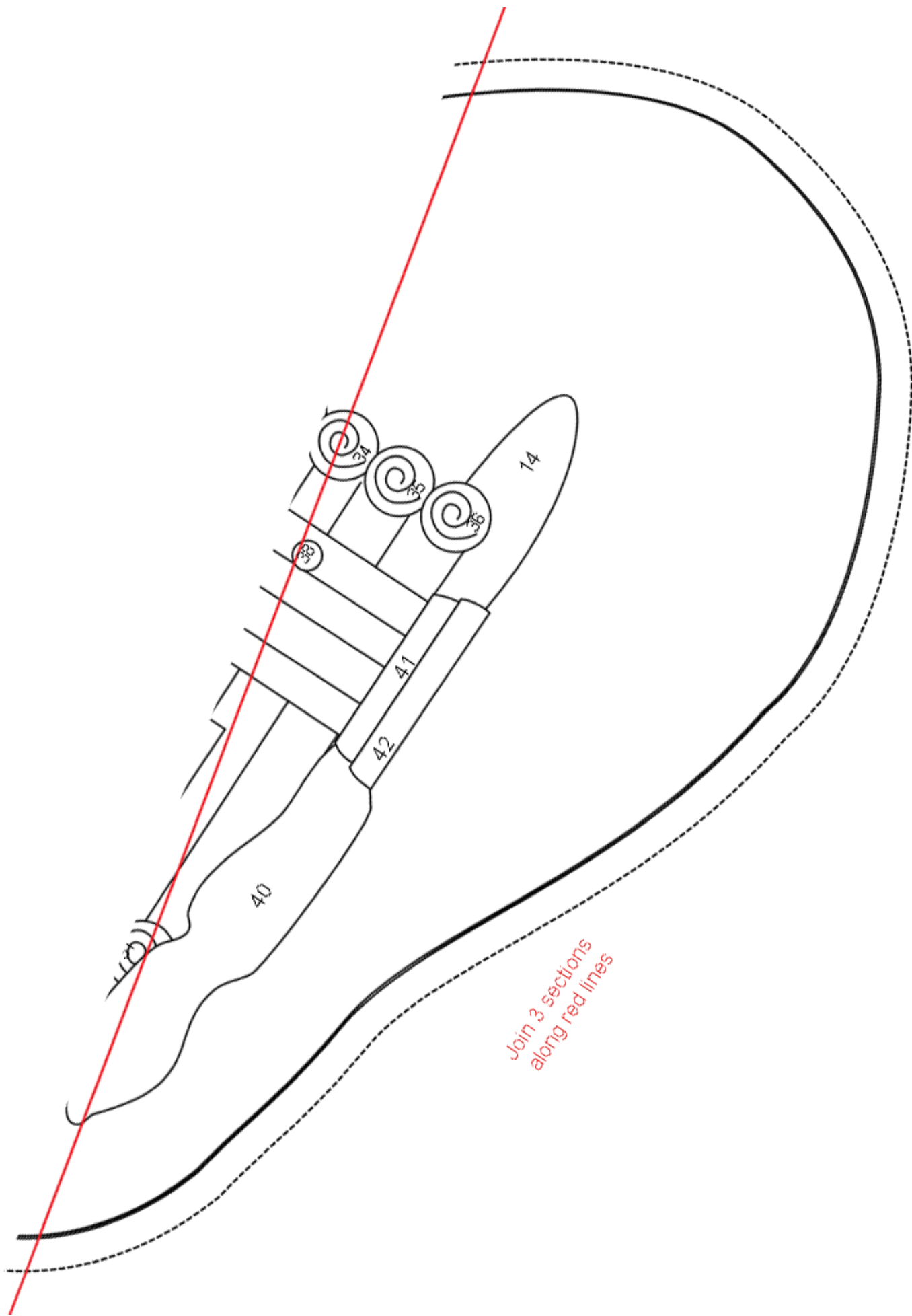
