

## Easy Wedge Table Topper



**Finished Size: 20"**

*Here's a fun and super fast way to put together a table topper for any occasion!*



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## Fabric Requirements

1. 4-5 fat quarters of different fabrics OR up to 20 scraps for the 20 wedges that make up this topper
2. One 21" square of backing fabric
3. One 21" square of batting

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using the template provided, cut twenty (20) wedges from up to twenty different fabrics.

*Alternatively, you can also use the Easy Dresden ruler - in this case, cut each wedge at the 8" line.*

2. Arrange the blades alternating the fabrics as you like, and then join them in quarters, using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance



3. Join the quarters in two halves.

4. Join the two halves to complete the circle.



5. Layer your batting, backing and wedge circle: place the square of backing wrong side down on the piece of batting. Place the wedge circle right sides together onto the backing fabric.

6. Sew around the outer edge of the wedge circle, using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Trim the backing and batting and clip the seam.

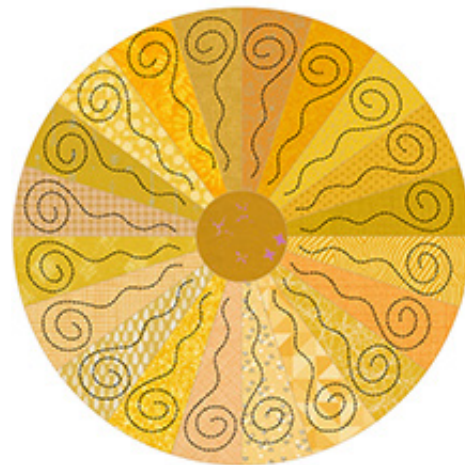
7. Turn the piece inside out through the small center circle, pushing the seam out gently to shape the piece. If necessary, press lightly with a steam iron.

8. Top-stitch the entire outside edge of the circle,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge.



- Applique the small center circle, closing the open space.

9. Quilt the topper. You can stitch in the ditch, or quilt a design in each wedge. If you like, a simple swirl pattern is included, should you like to try it.
